Re: Safety improvements to Northwest Arm Drive

As you know from previous correspondence, I have been lobbying the Department of Transportation to improve safety along Northwest Arm Drive, especially at the intersection with Walter Havill Drive and Albert Walker Drive.

For your information, I am attaching three recent pieces of correspondence between myself and the Minister. There was a change of Ministers on February 24th.

I am hopeful that funding for these improvements will be provided in the 2006-07 provincial budget. Normally the Legislature would be returning around this time, but the new government is holding off until early May. It is only then that we will know for sure whether these safety improvements will be funded.

I will keep you informed of this issue as it unfolds.
